Botetourt Music Academy

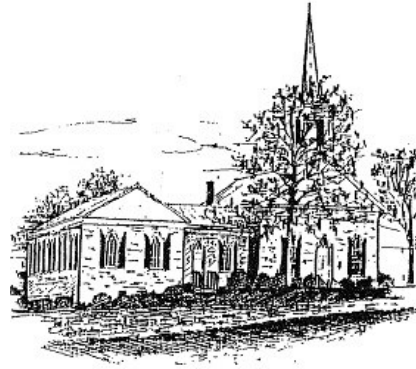
